## KINDERGARTEN VISITATION DAY - April 5 from 8:30-11:30

Calling all future kindergarten students for the 2019-2020 school year. We will be having a *Visitation day* on April 5 from 8:30 to 11:30, this will replace kindergarten round up. Students will "pretend" to be kindergarteners for the morning and be in the kindergarten classrooms. Students will be doing different activities during the morning such as a reading activity, art activity, and eating lunch in the lunchroom. The cost of lunch is \$2.10. If your child attends preschool at Central Springs it will be taken out of their account, if not you will need to bring \$2.10. Students who will be new to Central Springs will need to call the office to ask for a kindergarten packet. This will have information that the school requires you to have to attend kindergarten. You will return this packet on April 5. Those students who attend preschool at Central Springs will need to check into their preschool room and the students who are new will check into the kindergarten room that morning. If you will be attending the Manly building please call the office at 641-454-3283 and ask for Paula. If you will be attending the Nora Springs building, please call 641-749-5301 and ask for Laura. It is very important that you register for this day so we will know how many students will be attending. If you have any further questions you may call or email the kindergarten teachers. In Manly, you will need to contact Mrs. Kinne or Mrs. Richey. In Nora Springs you will need to contact Mrs. Greenzweig or Ms. Hamand. We look forward to seeing all the new kindergarten students on April 5 from 8:30-11:30.

## Central Springs Pre-School Program For 2019-2020

The Central Springs community School District is excited to offer a res-school program in the district for the 2019-2020 school year. Our pre-school programs are taught by certified teachers and consist of a research-based, age appropriate curriculum centered on the Iowa Quality Pre-school Program Standards (QPPS).

### Little Paws Pre-School (Manly Campus)

Who Can Attend: Children who will be 4 years old on or before September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019.  
Children turning 3 years old on or before September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019 may enroll also,  
but priority will be given to the four-year-olds.

The cost of the 4-year-old program is **FREE** to all families.  
The cost of the 3-year-old program is **FREE** to all families living in Worth County,  
or the original NS-RF school district is pending secured funding.

School Daycare will run ALL DAY...from 6:30am-5:30pm for all students enrolled in our preschool program to accommodate families who would like to use our services. Our daycare is DHS licensed and provides educational programming to its children throughout the day.

## Driver's Education

Driver's Education course will start in April. Mr. Dobel and Mr. Shafer will be co-teaching the class. A **mandatory parent/student meeting will be held at 5:00 PM on Tuesday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> at the Nora Springs building in the middle school small gym.** At the meeting, parents and students will hear issues related to the graduated license system; course guidelines and expectations, and get the Driver's Education class schedule. The meeting is part of the regulations mandated by the Department of Transportation.

The Dr. Ed class will be limited to 60 students. **All students must be signed-up by Wednesday, March 27<sup>th</sup>.** Registration forms will be available in the Middle School office at the Nora Springs Center and the High School office at the Manly Center. All students need to be at least 14 years old, have a valid driver's permit, and have their registration forms completed by Wednesday, March. 27<sup>th</sup>. The cost for this course is \$300.00; made payable to Central Springs.

The classes will be from 4 pm-6pm on Wednesdays until the end of the school year. Classes will be held in Nora Springs in April & in Manly in May. The final classes will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 7am-10am after the last day of school for 2 weeks. On Tuesday's the classes will be in Manly and Thursdays the classes will be in Nora Springs. The drive time procedure will be established during the 1<sup>st</sup> week of class.

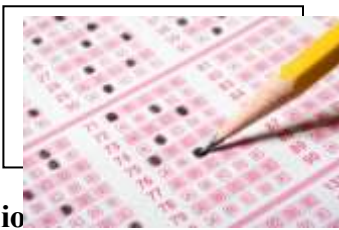
