Statement To Begin the 2021-22 School Year

Classes begin August 23, 2021

The Central Springs School District plans to fully return to and remain in the traditional (pre-pandemic), in-person learning model for all students and staff throughout the 2021-22 school year.

Given the uncertainty of the pandemic, the district will continue to follow guidance from public health officials and the State, and will adjust our education plan* if needed. The district will also continue to be diligent in its cleaning/sanitizing efforts to support public health.

If a student and/or family does not feel comfortable attending school in-person due to the pandemic, please contact a building administrator.

* Includes the potential use of the 2020-21 School Year Return-To-Learn instructional models (online or hybrid).

2021-22 SCHOOL YEAR OPERATION PLAN HIGHLIGHTS

- Return to and remain in traditional education model - *in person attendance required for all students and staff*
- Continue to follow guidance from county/state public health and the Iowa Department of Education
- Mask-wearing optional for students, staff and visitors, with the exception of on busses, given the Federal executive transportation order #13998
- Maintain certain cleaning/sanitization measures in support of public health
- Students/staff stay home when ill, isolate if symptomatic, and keep school nurses informed
