How is 1:1 going to improve scores?

The primary goal of iPad integration is to enrich the learning that takes place in and out of classrooms. In particular, technology offers opportunities for exploration and analysis of academic subjects in ways that traditional instruction cannot replicate.



How is 1:1 going to improve scores?

- All students have a computer at school.
- All students have an opportunity to access a school computer 24/7.
- All students have access to the Internet from 8:00-5:15 pm.
- All students have the correct apps needed to complete teacher-assigned tasks.



How is 1:1 going to improve scores?

- Teachers will plan lessons & activities knowing all students have the tools necessary to complete the task.
- Instruction time is not lost moving from computer lab & the classroom, & the flow of instruction is not interrupted by the unavailability of computers.



How is 1:1 going to improve scores?

- Students will have 21st Century Skills integrated into their curriculum, which moves technology skills out of a self-contained class & into the core content classroom for everyday use.

- effectively implement technology into the classroom.
- provide students appropriate guidance in the use of iPad technology.
- post assignments regularly on the MS webpage.
- update JMC on a regular basis.

- ensure my iPad is under my direct supervision or locked up at all times.
